

STEWARDSHIP GIVING

Blessed Sacrament has utilized WeShare since 2018 for making donating simple and easy, while at the same time keeping the process safe and secure. Over 75 parishioners currently use WeShare for their Online giving make online donations for their weekly/monthly offerings, as well as other parish collections. We have utilized this technology for the well-being and growth of our parish community. There is **no cost** to parishioners to participate in the WeShare online giving program.

You can set up a recurring weekly, semi-monthly, monthly, quarterly, or annual payment; allocate different amounts for our different collections; utilize a different payment method for each donation; and view complete, accurate financial records at any time. Those who wish to continue to use traditional methods of offering may do so; however, we ask that you prayerfully consider online giving.

Some of the benefits for parishioners include: no need to write checks; you can give even if you are unable to attend services; and your contribution amount can easily be adjusted.

The benefits for the parish include more consistent giving with recurring contributions; online donation summaries for record keeping; it reaches a wider demographic of givers; and accommodates all special parish collections and missions.

We will have individuals available after our masses on December 3rd and 4th to assist you with signing-up or to answer any questions you may have. You will need to have your bank routing number and account number or credit card information available.

Also, as cost continue to increase, such as utilities, supplies, etc., we need revenue to increase as well. If you have not increased your contribution in the last few years, we ask that you prayerfully consider doing so at this time. Increasing collection income allows for the continue delivery of our parish ministries and insures the continued financial wellness of our parish.
